- ii. If he is further aware that the tendering of the project building works had been done to evaluation stage and later cancelled early last year?
- iii. If he is also aware that the project building works were again re-tendered and advertised on 31st October, 2019 and closed on 22nd November, 2019 and up to date, the evaluation and award has never been done?
- iv. What necessitated the initial cancellation and what has caused the delay in the second tendering process?
- v. What is the duration of a standard tendering process, has the tendering process for this particular project adhered to the stipulated timelines?
- vi. How much was appropriated by the County Government and the EU donor respectively and in which financial year?
- vii. What are the scopes of works and timelines for implementation of this project?
- viii. What is the current status of the said abattoir?
- ix. When are the works going to begin to avoid roll-over of funds?
