- i. If he is aware that during the 2017/2018 financial year, ten plastic water tanks of 10,000 litre capacities were budgeted to be bought for ten (10)Tirioko ward ECD Centres?
- ii. If he is further aware that the ten Tanks were to be distributed to the following ECDE centres namely:

 - d) Kangiruru ECD

- v. Whether the aforementioned program has a policy framework to operationalize its activities?

- i. If he is aware that Kiptilit Slaughter House is currently in a pathetic state?

- iii. Is he aware that there is no lagoon for the treatment of solid and liquid waste emanating from the facility for safe release downstream considering that the untreated waste flows directly into KIRDAM (Kirandich Dam) which is the source of water for the entire Kabarnet Town?
- iv. Is he further aware that there is no sentry house at the gate of the facility to shelter the watchman in case of rain or harsh weather conditions?
- v. What management structure exists to take care of day to day running of this slaughter houses and county slaughter houses in general?
