### 7. STATEMENTS

**010/2020: Hon. Ernest Kibet**, **MCA**, **Kabarnet Ward**, seeks a statement from the **Chairperson**, **Livestock and Fisheries Committee** on the following matters of concern:

- i. If he is aware that Kiptilit Slaughter House is currently in a pathetic state?
- ii. If he is further aware that there is no watchman guarding the facility?
- iii. Is he aware that there is no lagoon for the treatment of solid and liquid waste emanating from the facility for safe release downstream considering that the untreated waste flows directly into KIRDAM (Kirandich Dam) which is the source of water for the entire Kabarnet Town?
- iv. Is he further aware that there is no sentry house at the gate of the facility to shelter the watchman in case of rain or harsh weather conditions?
- v. What management structure exists to take care of day to day running of this slaughter houses and county slaughter houses in general?
- vi. What measures is the County Livestock Department putting in place to remedy the prevailing situation?

**015/2020: Hon. Richard Cheserem, MCA, Saimo Soi Ward,** seeks a statement from the **Chairperson, Agriculture Committee** on the following matters of concern:

i. If he is aware that a budget of Kshs. 541,537 was set aside during the 2017/18 Financial Year for the purchase of ground nut seeds?

ii. If he is further aware that there were delays in purchase of the said seeds?

- iii. What occasioned the said delay?
- iv. Who were the intended beneficiaries of the ground nut seeds purchase scheme?
- v. What measures has the County Government put in place to ensure that the purchase of these seeds is expedited for the benefit of the targeted farmers?

**018/2020: Hon. Maureen Cherus, MCA, Baringo County,** seeks a statement from the **Chairperson, County Heritage, Gender, Culture and Community Services Committee** on the following matters of concern:

- i. If she is aware that there are several cases of Gender Based Violence (GBV) and teenage pregnancies in the County?
- ii. How many cases have been reported in the County so far?
- iii. If she is further aware that the said cases have been aggravated by the Covid- 19 pandemic where the Government directives to contain the spread through imposition of curfew and restriction of movement have resulted in financial constrains especially for families in informal settlements?
- iv. What plans and interventions does the County Government have in place to cushion the victims of the said violence to dignify them during these harsh economic times?

- i. If she is aware that Baringo County is one of the pastoralist Counties targeted for the Ushanga initiative?
- ii. How many groups have registered with cooperatives so far?
- iii. What was the criteria of engaging the women beaders for the initiative?
- iv. Is the County prepared to mainstream the initiative sustainably by the end of the 5years?

**021/2020: Hon. Betty Birchogo, MCA, Baringo County,** seeks a statement from the **Chairperson, County Heritage, Gender, Culture and Community Services Committee** on the following matters of concern:

- i. If she is aware that the National Government through the state department of culture and heritage launched the Work for pay" 100 Million Artists stimulus Package, in line with H.E President Uhuru Kenyatta's Executive order issued on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2020?
- ii. What were the criteria for engagement of the said package?
- iii. What was the mode of mobilization of the said artists participate in the exercise?
- iv. How many artists applied for engagement in the said programme?
- v. How many artists benefited from the programme in Baringo County at Ward level?

**024/2020:** Hon. Ameja Selemoi, MCA, Churo/Amaya Ward, seeks a statement from the Chairperson, Water and Irrigation Committee on the following matters of concern:

- v. Will the County Government purchase another water drilling rig as per the prioritization during the 2018/2019 Financial Year plan or will the same recently purchased one be given to Tiaty Sub County?
- vi. What measures is the County Government taking to ensure that Tiaty Sub County benefits from County Flagship projects/Programmes now and in the future?

i. If he is aware that several County Roads have been affected by the recent and on-going heavy rains?

ii. If he is further aware that some County Roads were affected by landslides and mudslides rendering them impassable especially during this heavy rains time?

- iii. Can the Chairperson give names of roads affected by (ii) above in the County?
- iv. Can the Chairperson indicate KERRA Roads per Sub County?
- v. Can the Chairperson further inform the House the other roads which have been proposed to be given to KERRA from County roads per Sub County.
- vi. What measures has the County Government put in place to ensure that the roads destroyed by the ongoing rains as described in (i) and (ii) above are repaired to motorable standards and all the roads in the County are maintained in good condition?

- iv. Are there modern ambulances, fully fitted with critical medical care and emergency services equipment in the County? If so how many are they? How many have been purchased by the County Government, how many have been donated by the donors?
- v. Where are the said ambulances stationed across the County?

vi. What plans does the County Government have to ensure that there are enough ambulances in the County especially for maternal and other emergency medical situations which is a fundamental right under article 43(2) of the Constitution?
