Mr. Speaker also the motions that we pass in this House, policies the regulations we realize that we are passing motions but the implementation of those particular motions or reports that are

passed in this House is not known because we need to know where the implementation has reached and we also need to push the executive so that they do what is expected of them because it is like nothing is moving and we are in a big mess and lastly we are heading to a weekend and I wish my colleagues a wonderful weekend full of God's blessings and also wish that as we go doing our businesses we make sure that we protect ourselves against this Covid-19.

This is a terrible disease I think when you look at the way people are dying in this Country it is a problem, in other Countries they are dying in thousands and we need to take precautions as Members and make sure that we do what it entails to make sure that we are safe as a House or as individuals and also our families.
