005/2020: Hon. Sam Limo Lourien, MCA, Tirioko Ward, seeks a statement from the **Chairperson, Education, Vocational Training and ICT** on the following matters of concern:

- i. If he is aware that during the 2017/2018 Financial Year, ten plastic water tanks of 10,000 litre capacities were budgeted to be bought for ten (10) Tirioko ward ECDE centres?
- ii. If he is further aware that the ten tanks were to be distributed to the following ECDE centres namely:
 - a) Domo ECDE
 - b) Chemayes ECDE
 - c) Dira ECDE
 - d) Kangiruru ECDE
 - e) Kreze ECDE
 - f) Chischis ECDE
 - g) Katagh ECDE
 - h) Loyamoi ECDE
 - i) Chepkirial ECDE
 - j) Kamurio ECDE
- iii. Can the Chairperson confirm if the said tanks actually reached the intended ECDE centres?
- iv. Can the Chairperson without the use of signed list from the department table before this Honourable House the acknowledgment and or receipt letters of the

said tanks from each of the intended ECDE centres with photographic evidence on the availability of the said tanks in each of the listed centres?

- v. What measures is the County Government taking to ensure that the said tanks are availed to the respective ECDE centres?

(The Public Accounts and Investments Committee to investigate further and deliver the thirteen (13) tanks by all means and recommend surcharging of the persons found culpable. The report to be tabled in three (3) weeks time)

8. MOTION

(HON. JULIA KANDIE, MCA, BARINGO COUNTY)

AWARE THAT, the Constitution Article 43(1) (d) acknowledges access to clean and safe water as a basic human right and assigns the responsibility for water supply and sanitation service provision to 47 established counties;

FURTHER AWARE THAT, the Constitution further contains provisions that touch upon water including affirmative action programmes to ensure water for marginalized groups;

ACKNOWLEDGING THAT, women and children in Baringo County have to walk for many kilometres so as to fetch water for their domestic use as well as for their livestock;

CONCERNED THAT, there had been water kiosks in most areas but the same are no longer operational due to poor management of their operations;

DISTURBED THAT, women and children have been suffering for long due to walking for long distance thus wasting the time that they could have been using doing other useful activities;

NOW THEREFORE, this Motion urges the County Government to:

Ensure that there are water kiosks in near all homesteads within the County such that women and children will not have to travel for more than 1.5 kilometres to fetch water for their use
