- c) Can the department also provide work tickets for the machines used?



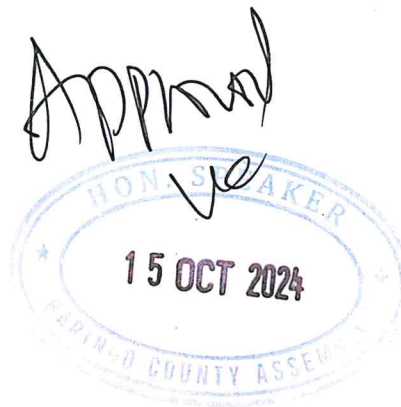
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- d) What action is the County Government taking to ensure that the use of fuel cards for every Ward and how long the policy on fuel cards take to be fully implemented for seamless service provision?
