003/2025 Hon. Julius Ngotie, MCA, Ravine Ward, seeks statement from the **Chairperson Trade, Tourism and Cooperatives Committee** on the following matters of concern;

THAT, the Constitution of Kenya 2010 provides for devolution of Trade and Co-operative Societies and that, the County Government of Baringo since the inception of devolution has been budgeting and disbursing loans to Small Medium Enterprises (SMEs).

THAT, Article 195(1) of the CoK 2010 as read together with Standing Orders 196(5) gives the County Assembly powers to compel production of documents and any important information.

Pursuant to the above;

- i. What was the initial amount budgeted for the SMEs?
- ii. What amounts have been disbursed and recovered since inception?
- iii. Give the status of repayments/recovered per Sub-County.
- iv. Provide the list of non performing accounts, giving the total sums of the loans defaulted.
- v. From the initial amount, how much has since been added to the Kitty in the subsequent County budgets?
- vi. Does each Sub-County have well updated ledger books? If so, please furnish the House with the updated ledger books?
- vii. Can each Sub-County operate a separate account for easy follow up?
- viii. Please give details on how the current Kshs.2 million was disbursed as per each Sub-County.

- ix. Give the status report of the Baringo County SMEs since inception to date per each Sub-County and;
- x. A detailed list of SME loans beneficiaries since inception as per Sub County.
- xi. Provide an updated ledger book for every loanee for the last three years SME disbursements.
- xii. Furnish this House with the latest updated Bank statement.

- iii. Which contractor was awarded the construction works?
- iv. Was the said contractor paid?
- v. What plans does the County Government have with respect to the construction of the said classroom without further delay?(The committee to make a site visit and confirm construction status, if it is true to the responds forwarded to the house with respect to Milimani ECDE and report back to the House)

THAT, Early Childhood Development Education (ECDE) is a fully devolved function, Noting that the construction of Kimoso 2 ECDE classrooms and 3 door latrine was allocated Kshs. 2,000,000 in the 2022/2023 FY.

The PP1 and PP2 Learners in the said ECDE centre are sharing a single classroom, in that respect therefore;

- i. How many classrooms were constructed in the ECDE centre by the County Government?
- ii. How many ECDE teachers are employed by the County Government and what are the terms of engagement?
- iii. What plans has the department put in place to ensure that more classrooms are constructed and equipped with desks and tables to facilitate conducive learning in the center?

015/2025: Hon. Sam Lourien Limo, MCA, Tirioko Ward, seeks a statement from the **Chairperson, Health Services Committee** on the following matters of urgent concern:

THAT, health is a fully devolved function with mandate to address all matters health for a healthy County and society;

Nurses of three dispensaries within Tirioko Ward were recalled and reposted. The nurse of Kamurio dispensary was recalled in the year 2023 and reposted elsewhere without a replacement. The nurse for Ptikiidispensary was recalled in the year 2022 and reposted elsewhere again without replacement. The nurse for Krezee

dispensary was recalled in the year 2024 and for the umpteenth time reposted elsewhere without a replacement.

- i. Why are nurses from the above mentioned stations recalled and reposted elsewhere without replacements?
- ii. Two of the said dispensaries (Kamurio and Krezee) served two locations each while the third one (Ptikii) served the local school community, a community of more than 10,000 people? What informed the decision to deny all these communities the health services provided by the recalled nurses yet they direly need and deserve these services like other Kenyans elsewhere in this Country?
- iii. What plans has the County Government put in place to ensure that this gross anomaly is corrected and the affected communities and people of Tirioko receive their well-deserved health services pursuant to Article 40 of the Constitution and other relevant laws of the land regarding citizen rights?
- iv. What plans has the County Government put in place to ensure that such gross acts which violate the constitutional and legal rights of the people are not repeated within TiriokoWard or any other part of this County?
