CONSIDERATION OF THE CONSTITUTION OF KENYA (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2020

AWARE THAT, Article 257 of the Constitution provides for Amendment of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 through popular initiative;

FURTHER AWARE THAT, Article 1 categorically states that all Sovereign power belongs to the people of Kenya and that the same shall be exercised either directly or indirectly through their democratically elected representatives;

EXERCISING our sovereign and inalienable right to defend, uphold and respect the **Supremacy** of the Constitution of Kenya as provided for in Article 2 of the Constitution;

RECOGNIZING THAT, Article 185 of the Constitution further provides that the Legislative Authority of a County Government is vested in, and exercised by the County Assemblies;

ACKNOWLEDGING THAT, Baringo County Assembly duly received the Draft Constitutional (Amendment) Bill, 2020 from IEBC through a letter dated 26th January, 2021 respectively;

FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGING THAT, the Draft Constitutional (Amendment) Bill, 2020 was laid on the table of the County Assembly on the 9th of February,

2021 and committed to the Committee on Justice, Legal Affairs, Devolution, Governance and Cohesion respectively;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Article 257(6) of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, Baringo County Assembly hereby **APPROVES** the Constitution of Kenya (Amendment) Bill, 2020 as presented

- vi. What was the total cost of transportation from the location of purchase and what are the individual breakdowns of transportation costs to the various destinations in the entire County?

- iv. Can the chairperson provide the list of all the recruits in UHC 1 and UHC 2 per cadre per Sub-county indicating the year of college completion?
- v. The chairperson to provide further the list of deployment per Sub-county and specific health facility the recruits are attached to?
